In a setback to the president, US district judge Andrew Hanen in Brownsville, a city along the Texas border with Mexico, issued a temporary court order on Monday stopping Obama's executive actions that bypassed a gridlocked Congress.

Hanen's action left in disarray US policy toward the roughly 11 million people in the country illegally.

Obama said he disagreed with the ruling and expected his administration to prevail once the issue made its way through the courts. "The law is on our side and history is on our side," Obama told reporters in the Oval Office. The president said the administra-

...illegal immigrants for deportation relief and work permits that had been set to begin on Wednesday.

"We will be prepared to implement this fully as soon as the legal issues get resolved," Obama said. "The department of homeland security will continue in the planning because we want to make sure as soon as these legal issues get resolved, which I anticipate they will in our favor, that we are ready to go." The justice department will appeal Hanen's preliminary injunction to the majority conservative 5th US Circuit Court of Appeals in New Orleans.

Hanen has previously issued other opinions critical of the Obama administration's enforcement of immigration laws. Hanen's preliminary injunction is not a ruling on the merits of the lawsuit filed by 26 states, led by Republican states such as Texas. REUTERS

## Nepal changes Everest route after accidents

Kathmandu: Nepalese officials said on Wednesday that they are changing the route that climbers take up Mount Everest after an avalanche killed as many as 16 guides last year, the deadliest accident in the mountain's history.

The new route will take climbers through the centre of the treacherous Khumbu Icefall just above Everest base camp, avoiding the section to the left of the glacier where last year's avalanche occurred.

"We will set a route around the centre to minimize risk of avalanche disasters," said Yangge Sherpa of the Sagarmatha Pollution Control Committee, the agency authorised to set the route. "We have already prepared the equipment required to begin the season," he said.

Nepal's icefall doctors — the highly skilled mountaineers who prepare the 8,848-metre (29,028 feet) peak for climbers — will go to Everest next month to fix ropes along the route, which was last used in the 1990s.

Tashi Sherpa, who has scaled the world's highest peak eight times, said the new route was less risky because there were no ice cliffs or hanging glaciers above it. These can break off suddenly, particularly as the weather warms in the spring, triggering rockfalls and avalanches. AFP
